1. Outstanding Riding President
2. Rebecca Grundy Award for Outstanding Campaign Management (Rookies)
3. Outstanding Campaign Manager (Veteran)
4. Outstanding Riding CFO/Treasurer for Riding Association or for Campaign
5. Outstanding Riding or Campaign Fundraiser (Creative & Successful)
6. Al Palladini Award for Outstanding Outreach
 - A person who promotes the PC Party of Ontario to their FRAN networks and to people who have not been involved before.
7. Outstanding Riding Database (PCHUB/Membership)
8. Michael Jakubcak Outstanding Riding Volunteer Award
 - This award has been renamed in memoriam of Michael Jakubcak, a lifelong volunteer.
9. Fran Kelly Award
 - An outstanding person who fundraises for the PC Ontario Fund.
10. Outstanding Riding Youth
11. Outstanding Website/Social Media
12. Special Achievement Award
 - Given to a volunteer who has made significant contributions locally and/or provincially on behalf of the party.
13. Judy Bobka Lifetime Achievement Award
 - This award is in memoriam of Judy Bobka, a lifelong party activist.
