Delivering for Dufferin-Caledon

Our PC Government continues to make significant investments to strengthen communities across Dufferin-Caledon:

Historic Health Care Milestone

The opening of Dufferin-Caledon's first MRI. Supported by the \$18 million Smart Headwaters campaign, this marks a major step forward in local care. The province is contributing more than \$800,000 annually to ensure continued access to diagnostic services close to home.

Mental Health & Community Safety

With over \$680,000 in funding, the Mobile Crisis Response Team (MCRT) is now supporting individuals experiencing mental health or addiction crises through a partnership among Caledon OPP, Dufferin OPP, and Headwaters Health Care Centre.

In addition, the opening of the Dufferin HART Hub (Homelessness and Addiction Recovery Treatment Hub) is expanding access to integrated mental health, addiction and housing supports, helping individuals connect to the care and services they need in one easy-to-access location.

Infrastructure & Growth

Early works for Highway 413 are underway, a major project that will help reduce congestion, improve travel times and support economic growth in Caledon and beyond.

Water Infrastructure

Supporting

- Orangeville: \$8+ million through the Housing-Enabling Water Systems Fund.
- Shelburne: \$12.5 million through the Health and Safety Water Stream.
- Grand Valley: \$1.3 million through the Health and Safety Water Stream.

Education Investment

A \$16.4 million investment is supporting the development of the new school in Mansfield, helping meet the needs of growing families in North Dufferin.

These investments are helping Dufferin-Caledon remain a strong, vibrant place to live, work and raise a family.

Specifically, Sylvia emphasized the government's progress on the Primary Care Action Plan, which is on track to connect every Ontarian to a primary care provider by 2029. With record investments to create and expand more than 300 primary care teams, the government is helping ensure everyone in Dufferin-Caledon and across Ontario can have a "primary care home" closer to where they live.
